#### **Music Director**

Juliane LaRocca has been directing and performing with various choral groups in the Greater Hartford area for more than twenty years, and is currently celebrating her tenth year as director of the Enfield Community Chorus.

She began studying piano privately at the age of five, transferring to the Hartt School of Music when she was thirteen. She continued her education at Hartt over the next decade, later adding organ performance and vocal instruction. She has performed as a soloist with the Hartford Symphony and directed numerous cabarets, concerts, and musicals including <a href="Legally Blonde">Legally Blonde</a>, <a href="Cabaret">Cabaret</a>, and <a href="You're A Good Man, Charlie Brown</a>. She is known for her unusual flair and directing style, and her groups have performed everything from Sondheim to Bach.

She is currently music director and organist at Ellington Congregational Church and lives in Windsor Locks.



#### **Accompanist**

Jonathan O'Brien is celebrating his 19th year as accompanist for the Enfield Community Chorus, after joining in 1999. Born and raised in New Bedford, MA, he began his studies in piano at age 5 with Felix Fournier, and continued with Daniel Beachman and Doris Sullivan in the Greater New Bedford area. He studied organ with Brian Roderick in Fairhaven, MA starting at age 15.

Mr. O'Brien was Organist for the Lakeville United Church of Christ in Lakeville, MA and has been Organist and Choir Director at First Congregational Church of East Windsor since 1998. He has been involved with productions of the Opera House Players and Cirillo Summer Theatre in Windsor, CT.

Mr. O'Brien holds degrees in Civil Engineering and Teaching, and tunes pianos in his free time. He currently resides in Stafford Springs, CT.

The Enfield Community Chorus was founded in 1976 when Alice Allen and Joyce Young collaborated on a musical, "200 Years of American Music", to present as part of Enfield's bicentennial celebration. Singers from local choirs joined together and enjoyed the experience so much that the group has continued to present annual Christmas concerts ever since, practicing and performing at the Hazardville United Methodist Church.

Currently, the group averages about 50 members. As the ECC continues to grow and set new goals, we are very excited to become more visible in the community. We believe that the act of singing and performing music is empowering in many ways, and the ECC provides a way to bring those benefits to your life. 
